

## NATIONAL DEFENSE AUTHORIZATION ACT 2019 (SECTION 889)

The John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act 2019 (NDAA) is a United States federal law which specifies the budget, expenditures and policies of the U.S. Department of Defense. The NDAA 2019 Section 889, prohibits the U.S. government from procuring video and telecommunication equipment from certain Chinese companies and their subsidiaries.

The National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) prohibits the use of equipment manufactured by a limited set of Chinese manufacturers. Video surveillance or security cameras are explicitly mentioned in the NDAA. We consider this when purchasing any new video equipment components or the finished products.

## The Companies Prohibited Under NDAA

A prominent fact to note is that the banned companies are from China, normally marked as Made in PRC (People's Republic of China). The surveillance and telecommunication equipment, internal components and chipsets from the following entities and their subsidiaries are prohibited from use in the US.

- Huawei Technologies
- ZTE Corporation
- Hytera Communications Corporation
- Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology
- Dahua Technology

Note that, even a minor component from the banned companies will prevent the usage of the complete equipment.

## **Wavesys Global Declaration of Conformity: NDAA**

Wavesys Global is pleased to affirm that our entire product portfolio, which includes solutions marketed to the US government, Department of Defense (DoD) and associated contractors and affiliates, is fully compliant with Section 889 of the John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2019.

NDAA Section 889 prohibits federal agencies, their contractors and grant or loan recipients from procuring or using 'telecommunications and video surveillance services or equipment' including certain components or critical technology from several outlined Chinese manufacturers.

We do not employ any SoC (System on Chip), or other components capable of processing software, from the banned Chinese companies.

The Wavesys IP 10 Series, IP 30 Series and IP 50 Series IP cameras along with IP-03 Servers, Storage & Workstations with our WS Series industrial grade switches are designed for use as part of video systems which comply with NDAA 2019, Section 889.

All our datasheets explicitly mention the chipset which are Ambarella, Intel and Qualcomm – NASDAQ listed SoC Chip manufacturers.
